There are estimated to be around a dozen Lime electric scooters located along Dominion Road, part of a 600-strong bike-share fleet deployed around Auckland streets.

Vaakore says it costs about \$14 an hour to hire the trendy newcomer in urban transportation.

"It's really good to use when patrolling not only Dominion Road (from Onslow to Balmoral roads) but Uptown as well," he says.

They are believed to be the first two business improvement districts to have adopted the new mode of transport.
